

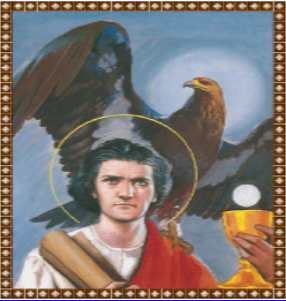

Operation Rice Bowl Reflection: God's Covenant
